



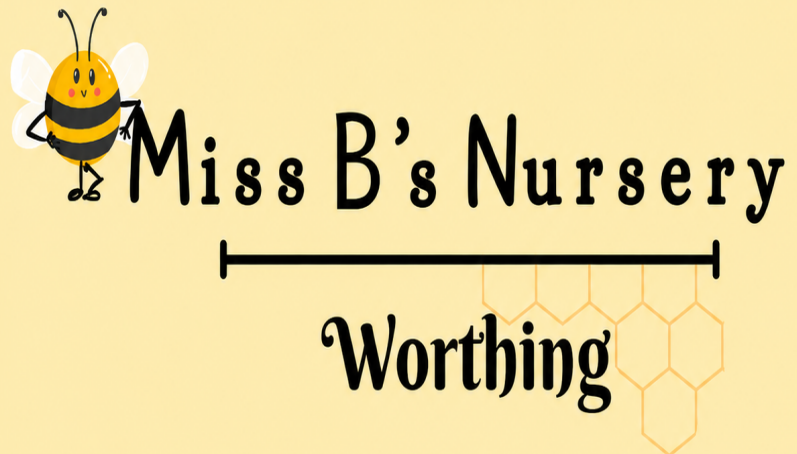

Our Fees

- ✓ Places are available all year round for 49 weeks per year.
- ✓ We are closed for all Bank Holidays, for which our fees will apply.
- ✓ As per our Admissions Policy, we reserve the right to change our fees with one month's notice, and they will be reviewed every April and September.
- ✓ Please see our Admissions & Fees Policy and Terms & Conditions for any further details.
- ✓ The days on which session options are available are subject to staff availability.
- ✓ Please see below the fees for each age group.
- ✓ To remain eligible for the childcare voucher scheme, parents must reconfirm their eligibility with HMRC every 3 months, or when prompted.
- ✓ The Government childcare allowance does not include a fee for consumable items such as sun care, nappies, creams, activities/resources above the core EYFS or meals.
- ✓ *Consumables will be a voluntary charge for EYFS hours of £1.90 for a full day and £1 for a half day. (Pro rata on Day 3 in accordance with EYFS hours)
- ✓ *Breakfast, morning snack, lunch, afternoon snack, dinner are all available at a voluntary charge of £6 for a full day and £3.50 for a half day. (Pro rata on Day 3 in accordance with EYFS hours)

Fees cont.

✓ The nursery does a stretched offer for childcare vouchers over 49 weeks.

Government allowance for 30 hours a week:

$1140 \text{ hours} / 49 \text{ weeks} = 23 \text{ hours per week}$ and the remaining 13 hours can be used as additional childcare, providing staff availability and sufficient notice.

So, for example, for 3 full days the first two days are fully funded, and the third day will be partially funded (3 hours). The remaining hours, out of the 10 hours for the third day, will be funded by parents.

Government allowance for 15 hours per week:

$570 \text{ hours} / 49 \text{ weeks} = 11.5 \text{ hours per week}$ and the remaining 6.5 hours can be used as additional childcare, providing staff availability and sufficient notice.

So, for example, for 3 half days, the first two half days are fully funded, and the third day will be partially funded (1.5 hours). The remaining hours out of the 5 hours for the third day, will be funded by parents.

For 3 months – 9 months old

Miss B’s Nursery is pleased to offer care for children from as early as 3 months of age. While government-funded childcare is currently available from 9 months onwards (subject to eligibility and scheme criteria), places for children under this age fall outside of the funded provision. Therefore, families requiring care for children aged 3 to 9 months will be required to pay private fees. Full details of our fee structure are provided below for your reference.

<i>*If parents/carers prefer a consumable product, i.e., nappies used, parents/carers are asked to supply these. Due to varying preferences in formula parents are asked to supply this in sealed ready-made cartons.</i>		

Transparency

- We do not charge parents for the 3 weeks (two weeks over Christmas and the final week in August) when the nursery is closed.
- Bank Holidays and Inset days are included on invoices.
- If your child is off due to illness or holiday, the session is still chargeable.
- If a child is collected late, a charge of £15 per 15 minutes (and every 15 minutes after (1-15,16-30,31-45,46-60 min)) will apply as digitally recorded by the staff member on the day.
- Late payments incur an automatic charge of £15, plus an additional £15 for each week after (from day 8 onwards), until the balance is settled.
- Invoices must be paid monthly in advance. They are reviewed each month, and the late instalments will incur standard late payment charges.
- Changes requested during the academic year incur a £15 administration fee per change, subject to availability, with 4 weeks' notice. A parent accessing EYFS hours has to give a term's notice for a change of hours.
- * Our catering company/ in-house cook provides healthy, balanced meals every day. This is an optional charge, but if you wish to provide your own food, it must align with what we serve at the nursery. The menus will be provided to you ahead of time to prepare them, in accordance with the Consumables, Food and Allergy Policy. We can highly recommend this meal plan as the meals are carefully planned by dietitians and only fresh and organic meals are prepared and served. Food for the day is charged at £6.00 (half day at £3.50) and consumables at £1.90 (£1 for a half day). Pro-rata for Day 3 in accordance with EYFS hours.
- If you wish to provide your own food, you can do so in accordance with our Food, Consumables & Allergy Policy. The food will have to be aligned with the nutritional standards we maintain at the nursery, and free of allergens. A list will be provided by the manager. Where a packed lunch provided from home does not meet NHS healthy eating guidance or our allergy and food safety requirements, we will discuss this with parents/carers and work together to identify suitable alternatives; where an item presents an allergy or safety risk, it will not be served, and a safe alternative will be provided where necessary.
- If parents/carers prefer a certain consumable product, parents/carers are asked to supply these.
